SAFETY & WARNINGS

Safety & Compliance

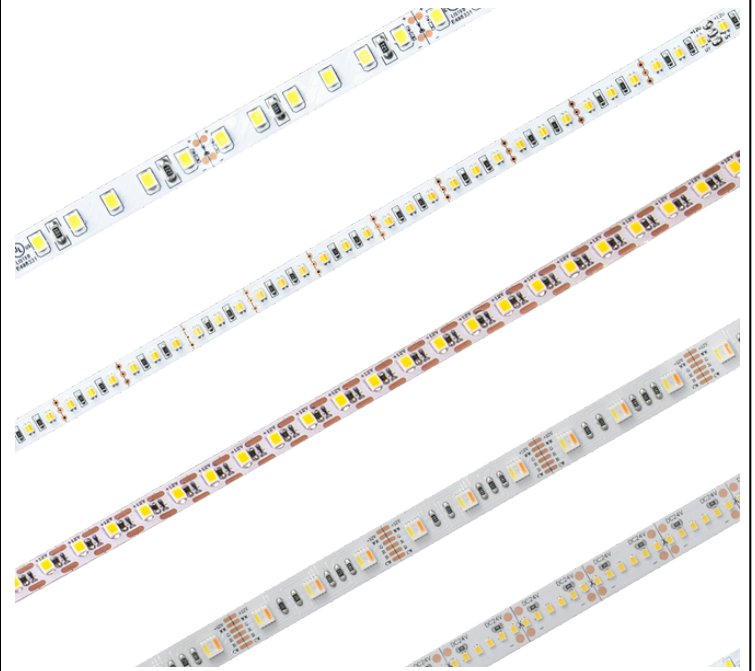
- Code Compliance: Install in accordance with all national and local electrical code regulations.
- Professional Installation: This product is recommended to be installed and serviced by a qualified, licensed electrician.
- Water Safety: Do not submerge this product, or do not install it within 5 feet (1.5m) of a swimming pool or spa unless the Tape light is specifically rated for that use.

Electrical & Installation Requirements

- Power Supply: Install only with a Listed Class 2 DC LED driver (in U.S.).
- Voltage Drop: To prevent a visible reduction in light output, ensure the wire gauge used is sufficient to maintain a voltage drop of less than 3%.
- Run Limits: Do not exceed the recommended maximum run length for this Tape Light.
- Cutting: Cut the Tape Light only at designated cut points. Cutting elsewhere will damage the product.
- Certain high-wattage Tape Light models must be installed within Luzumi LED profile channels to ensure proper heat dissipation.

Warranty Information

- Modifications: Do not modify the product beyond the provided instructions.
- Coverage: Failure to follow safety warnings and installation instructions will void the warranty and may result injury

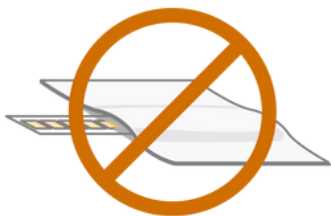

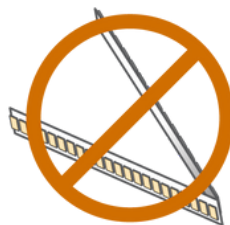
DO NOT CONNECT DIRECTLY TO LINE VOLTAGE POWER!

HANDLE WITH CAUTION



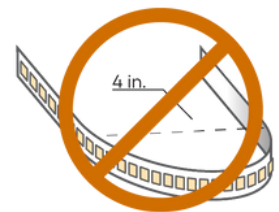
Ensure proper ventilation by keeping the LED tape light free of obstruction.



To prevent damage to the circuitry, do not fold, crease, or twist the tape light.



To prevent overheating, do not power the tape light while it is coiled or on the spool.



Do not bend the LED tape light tighter than a 4-inch diameter.
